Your first step to receiving services from Boulder County or the cities of Boulder or Longmont is by contacting CE. This is a required step for anyone seeking homeless-related services. You will talk with a staff person and go through a short assessment. Based on that information, you will be referred to the most appropriate services given your needs. CE is available in both Boulder and Longmont. Services may include shelter; help identifying housing options, basic-needs services, Case Mgmt. & more.
